Community Waste Educators – Bin Tagging 2025

The WMRC is running a bin tagging program for selected households across Subiaco, Cottesloe and Mosman Park and requires approximately 10 casual Community Waste Educators. Bin tagging assesses whether people are sorting their waste correctly by looking in their bins just before collection and labelling the bins with appropriate information. The program aims to inspect and tag bins from around 2000 households and runs for approximately 6 weeks (weather permitting). Not all staff will be required for the later weeks. This is a great opportunity for anyone seeking valuable field experience in the waste and recycling industry.

You will be trained, given all the equipment you need and will always be working with another person.

Requirements:

- Able to attend a training session in Subiaco on Thursday 13 February 10:00am – 12:00pm (paid)
- Over 18 with Australian citizenship or permanent residency.
- A reasonable level of fitness and able to walk for three hours.
- Mobile phone with at least iOS 13.0+ or Android 5.1+ software – app used for data entry.
- Regular availability for at least three of Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday for the duration of the project from 5:30/6:00am-9:00/10:00 am (approx.).

Desirable:

- Previous bin tagging experience
- Ability to explain activity to members of the public
- Current knowledge of WA recycling and FOGO rules
- App-based data entry experience.
- Current Motor Vehicle Driver's Licence and access to a car
- An interest in environmental management or sustainability

Wage: \$38.07 / hour including casual loading of 25%

Shift time: 5:30/6:00 am-9:00/10:00 am (or until tagging is complete for the morning, which may be earlier or later). Minimum hours of work would be 2 hours.

Dates: 13 February to late March (estimated)
